## What Volunteers Do

Volunteers are one example of the police-community partnerships that help to make Moorpark the safe and enjoyable place that it is.

Volunteers with the City of Moorpark provide the following Moorpark Police services to the community:

- **Patrol/Report Writing**—Volunteers receive specialized training which allow them to patrol the city acting as "eyes and ears" for the deputies. Volunteers serve as a mobile neighborhood watch program who observe and report suspicious activity throughout the city. In addition, volunteers write various crime reports such as burglaries, vandalisms and thefts.
- **Operations Support**—Volunteers assist in operations at parades, fairs, special events, emergency disaster scenes and in non-hazardous search and surveillance details. Volunteers also assist in Follow-up investigations and crime prevention.
- **Public Relations**—Volunteers staff the front counter of the police station and are often the first contact between the community and the police. Service referral is also given to people in need of services from other agencies.

## Applicant Requirements

The Moorpark Police Department, on behalf of the City of Moorpark, is always recruiting dependable individuals who are willing to serve their community. Applicants must be at least 21 years old, possess a valid driver's license, complete a routine background check and commit to 14 hours of service per month, including a monthly meeting.
